LUMBER PRICE INDEXES

In 2009, WWPA conducted an extensive survey representing greater than 70 percent of total softwood lumber volume produced by Western mills in 2007 and 2008. Survey data were used to construct an Index Log for each major western species. On a percentage basis, each species' Index Log indicates average recovery yielded by lumber grade and region.

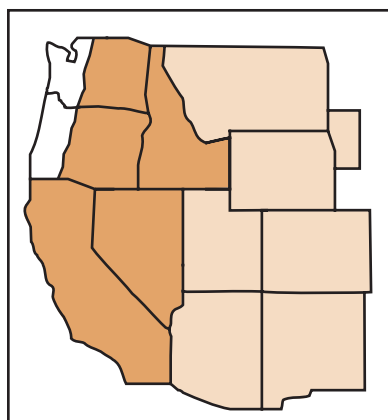
Beginning with the January 2010 issue, prices shown in the Inland Lumber Price Index will be based on Index Log grade recovery percentages derived from the 2009 survey. These percentages are averages and will vary by individual mill. Percentages reflect manufacturing trends but not variances in lumber shipments.
